

REPORT ON THE AUDIT OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Opinion

We have audited the attached financial statements of Popular Education & Action Centre (PEACE), New Delhi which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2023, and the Income and Expenditure account for the year then ended. Basis for Opinion

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:






